CRICKET NATIONAL AUDIT PROGRAM

The Cricket National Audit Program saw the development of the first national facility database of its type and depth for sport in Australia. The database program (Sports Facility Auditor – Cricket) was built using the National Community Cricket Facility Guidelines and allowed for Cricket Australia staff and contractors to undertake mobile on-site audits of every cricket venue across Australia.

SFA-Cricket data is now driving the preparation of State and Territory Cricket Infrastructure Strategies across the country, providing an evidence base from which to identify gaps, future needs and investment priorities.

Venue data is also integrated into the MyCricket fixturing software, driving all locational information collected at each venue, infrastructure data as well as individual match information and player data.

PROGRAM FUNCTIONS:

- Database of all playing fields from school sites to the Junction Oval
- o National benchmarking by State-Territory, cricket region and LGAs
- Assessment of female friendly compliant amenities
- Venue improvement project and investment tracking
- Mapping of all venues and associated facility elements
- Presentation of information via data dashboards
- Venue location data integrated with MyCricket match schedules
- Site specific provision and compliance assessment








Facility Hierarchy
