QLD FACILITY AUDIT PROGRAM

The QLD Facility Audit Program saw the development of the first detailed and coordinated state-wide audit of tennis facilities of its type for Tennis in Australia.

The Sports Facility Auditor – Tennis (SFA Tennis) program was used by Tennis Queensland staff to audit an initial 250 affiliated tennis venues across the State from the major centres in Brisbane and the Gold Coast, to Port Douglas in the far north and out to Mount Isa in the west.

Tennis Queensland Participation Leaders were trained in the use of the program and conducted hundreds of facility, participation and operational reviews to capture an extensive range of data to inform state, regional and localised venue and club planning.

SFA Tennis will soon become a national program with data set to drive the preparation of State and Territory Tennis Infrastructure Strategies across the country, providing an evidence base from which to identify gaps, future needs and investment priorities. Audits will be conducted in NSW and South Australia in 2019 to commence a nationwide audit of venues.

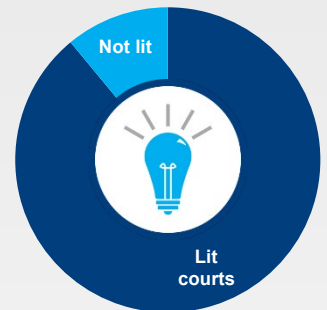

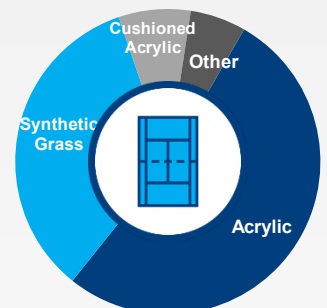
